Acorn Box

Outlin	e for making a box where the lid fits outside the body
1	Tenon on both ends
2	Mark about 1" waste at bottom & define with a parting line
3	Rough shape box body and roughly start forming the top to indicate shape
	As shown in illustration.
4	Part off the top from the bottom
5	Shape the inside and outside of the box bottom. Make sure that on the outside
	at the top that you leave about 1/4" that is 90° to the parted edge. Define the
	bottom to about 1" - 1.5" dia. Finish sand inside and out then part off what is left
	of the tenon
6	Mount top and make a 90° fit very firmly to fit over the outside of the box body.
	I suggest a small shelf that does not necessary match the depth of the cover fit.
	This way you can finish sand the next step without affecting the fit.)
7	Dome up the inside of the top and finish sand. Note: do not sand the inside
	edge that fits over the box body! Part off from the tenon.
8	Turn the top around and chuck it in expansion mode or a jam chuck. Finish
	carve and sand.
9	Mount the box body in expansion mode or with a jam chuck. Finish carve and
	sand.
