Pay your Club Dues



Over the first three months of this year, The Richmond Woodturners will be featuring a "Back to Basics" series for the monthly meetings. This is a great opportunity to invite a friend, woodworker, potential new turner to attend a club meeting with you. This might also be a good opportunity to invite a long time turner we have not seen for a while or get the new woodturning spouse some help.

AAW News on Liability Insurance: For more than 20 years, the American Association of Woodturners has purchased liability insurance that covered both AAW members and AAW chapters for any liability exposure arising from chapter-sponsored events (monthly demos). The cost to AAW ...in 2012 rose to \$23,000. Under new terms of proposed insurance for 2013, our premium would rise to more than \$175,000 (8X increase) to offer the same coverage to all chapters. Although we have engaged two agents to independently identify a carrier willing to write a policy extending pre-existing liability insurance for our chapters, we have not yet identified a suitable and affordable policy. In effect, this means we are not able at this time to implement a policy that we can extend to each chapter affiliated with AAW. Of course, chapters also may choose to seek liability coverage from providers in their local area. *[A new cost for the club!]*

You can announce in the newsletter that January's demonstration will be focusing on finish-turning dry, warped bowls. I'll be in charge of the demo, but may
